Location	St Anns Mills, Kirkstall, Leeds – one mile north west of the city centre
Description of Project	This project aims to provide a suitable incubation environment for new high growth businesses coming out of established incubation & high growth start up programmes in Leeds. The project will pay for a pre let of 12,000 sq ft of dedicated incubator space in newly refurbished Mill premises in the Kirkstall Valley. A pre let arrangement will enable the lead partner to create refurbished premises at affordable rates. Rental income accruing to the scheme will be used to provide incubation services, pay management costs and to establish a incubator fund for incubator clients. At any one time the incubator will be able to provide accommodation for up to 25 new high growth businesses in there first 3 years of trading. The incubator will operate a selective tenancy policy to ensure that priority is given to new growing businesses which have graduated from established high growth start up programmes currently operated by the two Leeds universities, Business Link West Yorkshire and the local Business Link concession (Leeds Chamber of Commerce). Space will be provided on flexible terms for a period of up to 12 months to enable new businesses to test out their business idea in a supportive environment. Incubation support services will be provided through the local business link concession, weekly advice surgeries will be held on site and tenants will be encouraged to take up appropriate support services accessed through the business link network. The project will enable partners to extend the current limited incubation offer by providing "grow on" space for existing incubation programmes.

Up to 25 businesses accommodated at any one time (@ 500 sq ft per business) 50/50 split between existing businesses (in their first 36 months of trading) & new businesses

Expenditure

A pre let of 12,000 sq ft at £15 per sq ft plus service charge (£2.50 per sq ft). Total charge of £17.50 per sq ft for 2.5 years. Service charges include building & grounds maintenance, security, lift, provision of utilities & building insurance etc.

£10,000 up front expenditure by YF for marketing costs.

Local authority contributions based on staff time to set up and run the project.

Rental Income

Rental Income accruing to the scheme will be ring fenced in a separate "incubation fund" account. The rental income forecast is as follows:

06/07 - 50% of max rental income (£15 per sq ft x 12,000 x 50%) = £90,000

07/08 - 70% of max rental income (£15 per sq ft x 12,000 x 70%) = £126,000

08/09 - 85% of max rental income (£15 per sq ft x 12,000 x 85%) = £153,000

total rental income = £369,000

The rental Income will be used to fund management & support costs of running the business accelerator and to establish a incubator fund. The incubator fund will be used to help businesses to develop & grow and will help to facilitate relocation of tenants to business accommodation in the private sector. The fund will therefore help to ensure "tenant churn" and stop "silting up" of the accelerator.
