Project: Bonfire Night Activities

Organisation: CATCH – in partnership with LCC Sports Service and West

Amount applied for: £1,268

Projected year of spend: 2013/14

Project overview:

The Neighbourhood Manager for Harehils has been working with partners - CATCH, the Police and the council's Sports Service - to create some events for the Bonfire Night period in Harehills, to build on the success of last year's activities to provide some positive celebratory events for the area.

A summary of the events being proposed is:

- Saturday 2nd November CATCH are opening their youth hub from 6-10pm, events at the HUB will include a pool and gaming tournament with prizes to encourage people to stay the duration of the evening.
- Monday 4th November An outdoor roller disco event in Ashton Park with music, skating, youth bus and a 'Smoothie Bike' for healthy snacks.
- Tuesday 5th November A football tournament also in Ashton Park with music and prizes.
- In addition CATCH will also be opening the HUB additional hours on the 4th and the 5th November for young people who would prefer this activity instead.
- It is also hoped that there will be capacity to staff the areas ASB hotspots with the council's Youth Service and the Police to encourage young people to attend the events.

£180 towards this project has already been secured from POCA funding. The event will be staffed through a combination of CATCH volunteers, members of the Area Support Team, the council's Youth Service and the Police plus staff from other agencies.
