The funding supported the delivery of

- At least 73 projects throughout the year
- 20 Breeze projects including local mini breeze events and back yard breeze events
- Two areas secured match funding to the value of £68k for the delivery of 34 projects during the summer holidays

Universal Activity fund is for local delivery of play, sports, arts and cultural activity for children and young people age 8 to 17 years across the city of Leeds.

2013/14 was the first year for local delivery of the universal youth activity fund to the value of £262,500.

£250,000 for local delivery through Area Committees and £12500 for delivery in the city centre.

2567 children and young people attended the breeze events

At least 3535 children age 8-11 attended the activities

At least 2757 young people age 12-17 attended the activities

At least 1022 unknown/ younger/older children and young people
