Health and Safety Service Proposed controlled measures under the Licensing Act 2003

Having considered the application under the Licensing Act 2003 for the above premises, the Health and Safety Service considers that the following measures are proportionate and necessary in order to promote the public safety licensing objective:

Measures proposed:

No	Potential Control Measures
	Public Safety 4 :- Fire/Electrical Safety
1.	Electrical installations will be inspected on a periodic basis (at least every 3 years or at a frequency specified in writing) by a suitably qualified and competent person. If used, any temporary electrical wiring and distributions will also be inspected. Inspection records/certificates will be kept. These will be made available at the request of an authorised officer.
2.	One of the following protective measures shall be used for all socket-outlets which may be used for the connection for lighting, video or sound amplification equipment and display models:
	a) Each socket-outlet circuit shall be protected by a residual current device having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA. or
	b) Each individual socket-outlet shall be protected by an integral residual current device having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30mA.
	The current operation of all residual current devices shall be checked regularly by pressing the test button. If the device does not switch off the supply, an electrical contractor should be consulted. At the same time action should be taken to prohibit the use of socket outlets associated with a faulty residual current device.
	Public Safety 6 :- General Housekeeping
3.	Safety glass that is impact resistant should be used wherever possible in all areas where the public may come into contact with it. Where it is not used in public areas, glazing should be shielded to protect it from impact.
4.	A written spillage policy will be kept to ensure spillages are dealt with in a timely and safe manner
	Public Safety 8 :- First Aid
5.	A suitably trained first aider or appointed person will be provided at all times when the premises are open.
	Public Safety 9 :- Special Effects
6.	Where strobes, lasers, smoke machines or any other special effects equipment may be used, a written health and safety policy covering all aspects of their use will be provided, and staff will be appropriately trained.

The Health and Safety Service is satisfied that the proposed measures are not adequately dealt with by other legislation.

By signing the declaration enclosed overleaf the applicant agrees to incorporate the proposed measures as conditions within the operating schedule for the said premises.
