Area Management recommendation

The guidance notes state that small grants are not available for everyday running costs and if this was changed unless in exceptional circumstances we could find substantial demand for small grants for these everyday costs rather than the 1-offs that the grants are designed for. Exceptional circumstances could included, for example, community forums which Area Management has provided direct support in the past but is no longer providing this support. This does not apply to this application.
