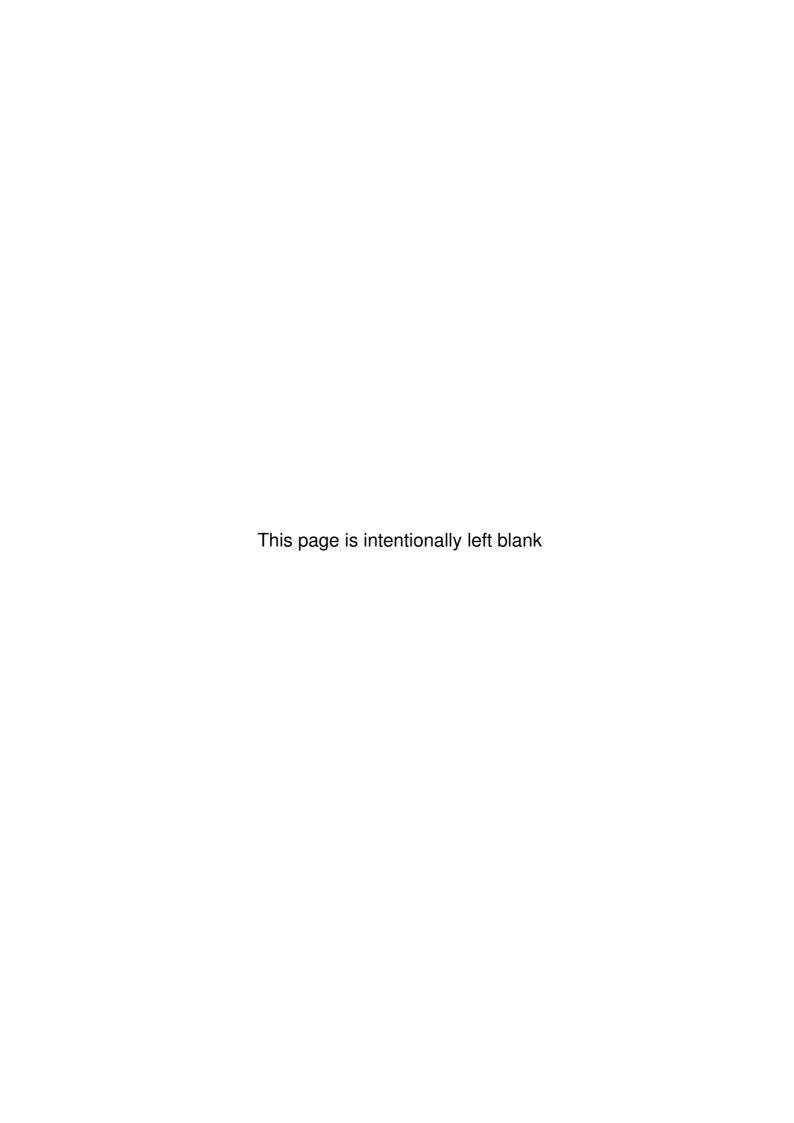

Executive Summary

To inform members of the RDDP of the proposed fees for the Cemeteries and Crematoria Section, the fees if approved will commence from 1st October 2007, members are requested to approve these fees.

1.0 Purpose of the Report

1.1 To present the proposed Fees and Charges for the Cemeteries and Crematoria Section, the proposed fees would apply from 1st October 2007, See Appendix 1

2.0 Background Information

2.1 The fees and charges for the Cemeteries and Crematoria Section increase on the 1st October each year. The proposed fees attached meet the requirements of Central Finance whilst at the same time provide funding for the Memorial Testing Programme and developments to the service.

3.0 Main Issues

3.1 The proposed increase is based on a 5% increase on all charges.

- 3.2 Over the past 2 years increases in prices have been agreed above the rate of inflation, but no funds were released into the Memorial Testing Programme, it was agreed a number of years ago to put £50,000 per year into this budget to achieve a 5 year testing programme. If £50,000 is not injected into the budget from this price rise, then alternative funding must be identified to enable the Cemeteries Section to get anywhere near to a 5/7 year rolling testing programme.
