Moor Allerton Elderly Care

Moor Allerton Elderly Care (MAECare) is a registered Charity (Reg.No. 1100645) established by, and at all times answerable to, Churches Together in Moor Allerton and Shadwell (CTMAS).

Its aims are:

- To improve the quality of life of older local people, regardless of religion or belief, race, disability, gender or sexual orientation
- Accepts and values each individual member, volunteer and employee
- Acts as a link to existing services and seeks to address unmet demand.

The Management Committee shall consist of not more than 20 people residing in, or members of churches in, the community of Moor Allerton or Shadwell, and is appointed annually by CTMAS at its AGM. Trustees do not have to be City Councillors, but the Council's nominee has always been a Local Member.

June 2010 Update

This is an annual appointment and up to 2009/10 was appointed by the North East (Outer) Area Committee. Since then, the North East (Inner) Area Committee (part of which area is covered by MAECare) was requested to consider making an appointment, and on this basis, **Councillor Lancaster** was appointed. It has been agreed, in consultation with Harewood and Alwoodley Members, that the process of appointing a Member from the North East (Inner) Area Committee continues in 2010/11.
