Name of Project: Driving Training

Ward Affected: All wards

Name of delivery organisation: Youth Service Amount requested: £2460 (£615 per ward)

The Youth Service want to take local young people to more events, activities and inter-area events. They are limited by transport as the Outer North West is a large area and public transport is relatively limited compared to the inner areas. The funding would pay for two staff members to gain a driving qualification to drive passenger minibuses. Costs are also required to pay for additional staff to cover the sessions and programmes of work whilst the staff are on the training course. The application was discussed at the Children & Young Peoples sub group on the 2nd November with officers from the youth service. The sub group supported the application and recommended that it is funded by the Area Committee.
