#### **Summary of main issues**

This is an application to vary a premises licence for Rani Superstore 82 Osmondthorpe Lane, Osmondthorpe, Leeds, LS9 9EF

The application is for the Sale by Retail of Alcohol everyday between the hours of 00:00 to 23:59 as detailed in 4.3.

#### 1.0 Purpose of this Report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 34 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") to vary a premises licence in respect of the above mentioned premises.

#### Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

- No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence
  - a. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

#### Embedded restrictions attached to the licence by virtue of grandfather rights.

4. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.

In this condition, permitted hours means:

- a. On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, 8 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- b. On Sundays, other than Christmas Day, 10 a.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- c. On Christmas Day, 12 noon to 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.
- 5. The above restrictions do not prohibit:
  - a. the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
  - b. the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- 6. Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container or be consumed in the licensed premises.



Thank you for submitting your application for the above premises, this application was received, at the address above, on 15 June 2012.

West Yorkshire Police are of the opinion that your application contains insufficient information about how you intend to meet the licensing objectives.

We therefore confirm that we are submitting a formal representation against your application on the grounds of-:

- 1. the prevention of crime & disorder
- 2. the prevention of public nuisance, and
- 3. the protection of children from harm.

This application seeks the grant of a premises licence for off sales only. The details of the application are set out below:

The premises seek the grant of a premises licence for 24 hour sales seven days a week.

Seasonal variations have been applied for in respect of Christmas Day and Good Friday.

West Yorkshire Police would not support an application of this nature, based on a number of factors. The premises are situated in a 'challenging' area with high figures recorded in respect of crime and antisocial behaviour (ASB). Whilst a significant amount of work has been undertaken to try and reduce the calls for service and reported crime, calls and crimes are still significant. Occurrences at the store place the premises as the highest commercial premises in the area. ASB relates mainly to nuisance youths with 'alcohol related' and 'youth related' incidents being the two top qualifiers in the recorded data. The

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fear is that the store will attract customers from far and wide, thereby escalating the problems in the immediate vicinity.

If this application is granted this will be the only 24 hour off licence store in the area. The very real fear is that the store will become a magnet for those wishing to consume alcohol late into the evening and thereby extend the night time economy.

West Yorkshire Police would ask that the Licensing Committee reject this application.

Thank you for submitting your application for the variation of Premises Licence.

The application premises are situated adjacent to vehicle repairs garage and National Health Service Building, however, the surrounding area in predominantly residential in character. The premises comprise a ground floor grocery shop with an off Licence together with a living accommodation above which is accessed by a separate entrance to the side of the building. It is not known if the living accommodation is occupied by the applicant. Diagonally opposite the application premises (some 25 meters away) are residential properties.

#### Impact on neighbouring properties (Late night noise and disturbance)

The current opening hours of the premises (for the retail sale of alcohol) are as follows:

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0800 hours – 23:00 hours (Monday – Saturday) 0800 hours – 22:30 hours (Sundays).
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The applicant is now seeking to sell alcohol from the premises on 24 hour basis 7 days a week. Given that there are residential properties situated close to the application premises, the Department has some concerns that the late night opening hours of the premises will generate noise nuisance complaints from the nearby residents (and from the residents living above the shop if it is not occupied by the applicant) by way of comings and goings of customers, opening and closing of shop door and noise from vehicles (car horns, banging doors, car stereos, engines revving etc) and anti-social behaviour problems.

In my opinion there are no other shops in the area that have been granted late night licences to sell alcohol after 23:00 hours, and should the application premises be granted 24 hour licence, it will provide a focal point for the customers and could also set a precedent encouraging other shops in the area to follow suit.

In view of the above concerns, Leeds City Council's Health and Environmental Action Service (HEAS) fully objects to this application as there is a greater potential for public nuisance to noise sensitive occupants which will undermine the prevention of public nuisance objective of the Licensing Act 2003.
