Summary of main issues

- 1.1 To advise Members of a temporary event notice served under section 100 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") in respect of the above mentioned premises.
- 1.2 Members are required to consider this notification due to the receipt of an objection notice from Environmental Protection Team.

2 History of premises

2.1 There is no premises licence in place for theses premises.

3 The temporary event notice

- 3.1 The proposed premises user is Miss Rachel Noble.

The capacity for the event is 250 persons.

3.4 The location of the premises can be seen on the map at Appendix B.

4 Representations

- 4.1 West Yorkshire Police and LCC Environmental Protection Team have received a copy of the notice.
- 4.2 Environmental Protection Team consider that allowing the premises to be used in the manner set out in the temporary event notice will undermine the prevention of public nuisance and have issued an objection notice. A copy of this is attached at Appendix C.

5 Equality and diversity implications

5.1 At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the Licensing Sub-Committee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.

6 Options Available to Members

 - Issue a counter notice against the event in order to prevent the event from taking place.
 - If the premises benefits from a premises licence, attach relevant conditions which are attached to that premises licence
 - Allow the event to take place
- 6.2 Members of the licensing sub committee are asked to note that they may only attach conditions that are present on the premises licence and are relevant to the activities stated on the temporary event notice.





Licensing Act 2003 - The Prevention of Public Nuisance Temporary Event Notice 27th May 2017at 12:00 hours 23:59 hours. Name and Address of Premises: Premier Banqueting Suite, Stoney Rock Lane, Burmantofts, Leeds, LS9 7TZ.

We refer to your recent submission of a Temporary Event Notice (TEN). As the responsible authority for public nuisance issues, the Council's Environmental Health hereby give you Notice that we are objecting to this TEN as we are satisfied that by allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine a licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance for the following reasons:

The premises are surrounded by residential properties and over the years the Environmental Protection Team have received noise nuisance complaints from the residents by way of amplified music escaping from the premises and noise disturbance caused by coming and goings of patrons. It is, therefore advised that in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 the Council's Licensing Section serve counter notice in relation to this application.
