9.0 Confidential information – requirement to exclude public access

9.1 The public must be excluded from meetings whenever it is likely in view of the nature of the business to be transacted or the nature of the proceedings that confidential information would be disclosed. Likewise, public access to reports, background papers, and minutes will also be excluded.

9.2 Confidential information means

- (a) information given to the Council by a Government Department on terms which forbid its public disclosure or
- (b) information the disclosure of which to the public is prohibited by or under another Act or by Court Order. Generally personal information which identifies an individual, must not be disclosed under the data protection and human rights rules.

10.0 Exempt information – discretion to exclude public access

- 10. 1 The public may be excluded from meetings whenever it is likely in view of the nature of the business to be transacted or the nature of the proceedings that exempt information would be disclosed provided:
 - (a) the meeting resolves so to exclude the public, and that resolution identifies the proceedings or part of the proceedings to which it applies, and
 - (b) that resolution states by reference to the descriptions in Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 (paragraph 10.4 below) the description of the exempt information giving rise to the exclusion of the public.
 - (c) that resolution states, by reference to reasons given in a relevant report or otherwise, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
- 10.2 In these circumstances, public access to reports, background papers and minutes will also be excluded.
- 10.3 Where the meeting will determine any person's civil rights or obligations, or adversely affect their possessions, Article 6 of the Human Rights Act 1998 establishes a presumption that the meeting will be held in public unless a private hearing is necessary for one of the reasons specified in Article 6.
- 10. 4 Exempt information means information falling within the following categories (subject to any condition):
 - 1 Information relating to any individual
 - 2 Information which is likely to reveal the identity of an individual.
 - Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information).
 - Information relating to any consultations or negotiations, or contemplated consultations or negotiations, in connection with any labour relations matter arising between the authority or a Minister of the Crown and employees of, or officer-holders under the authority.
 - Information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings.
 - 6 Information which reveals that the authority proposes
 - (a) to give under any enactment a notice under or by virtue of which requirements are imposed on a person; or
 - (b) to make an order or direction under any enactment
 - 7 Information relating to any action taken or to be taken in connection with the prevention, investigation or prosecution of crime

Summary of main issues

This is an application for the grant of a premises licence, made by Teraza Yosef, for Richmond Hill Shopping Mart 9A Upper Accommodation Road, Cross Green, Leeds, LS9 8RZ.

Responsible authorities and Ward Members have been notified of this application.

The application has attracted representations from other persons and responsible authorities.

1 Purpose of this report

- 1.1 To advise Members of an application made under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") for a new premises licence in respect of the above mentioned premises.
- 1.2 Members are required to consider this application due to the receipt of representations.

2 History of the premises

2.1 This is the first application for a premises licence for these premises.

3 The application

- 3.1 The applicant's name is Teraza Yosef, .
- 3.2 The proposed designated premises supervisor is Teraza Yosef
- 3.3 In summary the application is for:

Sunday	11:00 - 16:30

4 The operating schedule

4.1 The applicant proposes to promote the licensing objectives by taking the steps identified in the operating schedule which is attached at Appendix A.

5 Location

5.1 A map which identifies the location of this premises is attached at Appendix B.

6 Representations

6.1 Under the Act representations can be received from responsible authorities or other persons. Representations must be relevant and, in the case of another person, must not be frivolous or vexatious.

Representations from Responsible Authorities

Representations have been received from West Yorkshire Police in their capacity as a responsible authority. Any representation may be negotiated prior to the hearing. In this instance the operating schedule has been amended to include the measures agreed with West Yorkshire Police Appendix C.

Other representations

- The application has attracted representations from members of the public (described as 'other persons' in the legislation).
- The licensing authority is in receipt of 24 individual letters of objection, a petition containing 70 signatures and a letter from the ward councilor, all of which are opposed to this application on the grounds of Crime and Disorder, Protection of Children from Harm and Prevention of Public Nuisance.
- In order to protect personal data, redacted copies of the representations are attached at Appendix D. Unredacted copies will be available at the hearing for Members consideration.

7 Licensing hours

- 7.1 Members are directed to paragraphs 6.8 to 6.15 of the Statement of Licensing Policy which states the criteria that will be applied to any decision for new applications or variations which include extending hours.
- 7.2 In brief the Policy states at 6.14 that restrictions may be made to the proposed hours of use where, after receiving relevant representations, the council considers it appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives to do so.
- 7.3 The council will take into account the existing pattern of licensed premises in an area when considering what is appropriate to promote the objectives. Applications which are significantly out of character for a locality will need to demonstrate that granting the hours sought will not adversely impact on the licensing objectives.
- 7.4 A list of premises in the local area and their licensed hours and activities is provided at Appendix E.

8 Equality and diversity implications

8.1 At the time of writing this report there were no implications for equality and diversity. Any decision taken by the licensing subcommittee will be in accordance with the four licensing objectives as prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003.

9 Options available to Members

- 9.1 The licensing subcommittee must take such of the following steps as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:
 - Grant the application as requested.
 - Grant the application whilst imposing additional conditions and/or altering in any way the proposed operating schedule.
 - Refuse to specify the said person as the designated premises supervisor.
 - Reject the whole or part of the application.
- 9.2 Members of the licensing subcommittee are asked to note that they may not reject the whole or part of the application merely because they consider it desirable to do so. It must be appropriate in order to promote the licensing objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A log book or recording system shall be kept upon the premises in which shall be entered particulars of inspections made, those required to be made by statute, and information compiled to comply with any public safety condition attached to the premises licence that requires the recording of such information. The log book shall be kept available for inspection when required by persons authorised by the Licensing Act 2003 or associated legislation. Training and implementation of underage ID checks.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Deliveries of goods necessary for the operation of the business will be carried out at such a time or in such a manner as to prevent nuisance and disturbance to nearby residents

Customers will not be admitted to premises above opening hours

Any lighting on or outside the premises will be positioned and screened in such a way so as to not cause a disturbance to nearby residents

e) The protection of children from harm





Thank you for submitting your application for a premises licence at the above address, which we received on 21st November 2017.

West Yorkshire Police are of the opinion that your application contains insufficient information about how you intend to meet the licensing objectives.

We therefore confirm that we are submitting a formal representation against your application on the grounds of-:

- 1. the prevention of crime & disorder
- 2. the prevention of public nuisance, and
- 3. the protection of children from harm.

However, West Yorkshire Police are also of the opinion that the said objectives could be met should you be prepared to incorporate certain identified measures within your operating schedule, in <u>addition</u> or as an <u>alternative</u>, to what you may have offered in your application.

Please find enclosed a document which at Part 1 contains the suggested measures which this authority considers are proportionate and appropriate to the nature of your application.

Should you be in agreement with the suggested measures then please signify this by completing and signing Part 2 of the enclosed form and return the complete document to this office as soon as possible, but no later than 22nd December 2017.

Upon receipt of your consent at Part 2, it will be taken that you signify your wishes for the licensing authority to amend your operating schedule to incorporate the proposed measures.

Alternatively should you disagree with the proposed measures, then please complete Part 3 and again return the complete document to this office as soon as possible, but no later than 22nd December 2017.

Having considered the application under the Licensing Act 2003 for the above premises, West Yorkshire Police considers that the following measures are relevant, proportionate and necessary in order to promote the following licensing objectives:

- the prevention of crime & disorder
- the prevention of public nuisance
- · the protection of children from harm

Measures / Additional measures proposed:

- A suitable Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) system will be operational at the premises at all times when licensable activities are being carried out and at any other times where members of the public are present on the premises.
- The CCTV system will cover all areas of the premises occupied by the public under the terms of the licence, including entrances and exits and all areas where all alcohol is displayed for sale.
- The CCTV system will contain the correct time and date stamp information,
- The CCTV system will have sufficient storage retention capacity for a minimum of 31 days' continuous footage which will be of good quality.
- A designated member / members of staff at the premises will be authorised to access the CCTV footage
 and be conversant with operating the CCTV system. At the request of an authorised officer of the
 Licensing Authority or a Responsible Authority (under the Licensing Act 2003) any CCTV footage, as
 requested, will be downloaded immediately or secured to prevent any overwriting. The CCTV footage
 material will be supplied, on request, to an authorised officer of the Licensing Authority or a Responsible
 Authority.
- Alcohol will not be displayed next to the public entrance / exit of the premises at an time, and will be
 displayed so that it is capable of being supervised by staff at all times,
- A Supervisor's Register will be maintained at the licensed premises, showing the name, address and up-todate contact details for the DPS and, any other person left in charge of the premises by the DPS.
- The Supervisors Register will state the name of the person who is in overall charge of the premises at each time that licensed activities are carried out, and this information will be retained for a period of twelve months and produced for inspection on request to an authorised officer,
- The Premises Licence Holder / Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that an Incident Report Register is maintained on the premises to record incidents such as anti-social behaviour, and refusal of alcohol sales to minors.
- The Incident Report Register will contain consecutively numbered pages, the date and time of the incident, details of the nature of the incident, the names and personal licence numbers (if any) of any staff involved or to whom the incident was reported, the names and numbers of any police officers attending, the police incident and / or crime number, names and addresses of any witnesses and confirmation of whether there is CCTV footage of the incident,
- The Premises Licence Holder / Designated Premises Supervisor / all members of staff will ask for proof of age from any person appearing to be under the age of 21 who attempts to purchase alcohol at the premises.

West Yorkshire Police are satisfied that the proposed measures are not adequately dealt with by other legislation.

Executive Summary

To advise Members of an Application for the certification of film to be shown at the Vue Cinema, 22 The Light, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 8TL. The screening will be on the 31 January 2018 for 1 day only.

1.0 Purpose of this report

1.1 This report informs Members with the background, history and issues of an application made under the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act") for the certification of films that do not currently have a BBFC (British Board of Film Classification) certification. Finally, this report informs Members of the options available to them when considering an application for the certification of films.

2.0 Background information

- 2.1 The Licensing Act 2003 applies to premises which provide film exhibitions. At present there are a total of 7 cinemas licensed in the Leeds District.
- 2.2 The majority of films shown in Cinemas will carry a Certificate from the BBFC the categories of which are as follows:

Category `U' Passed for general exhibition

Category `PG' Passed for general exhibition but parents/guardians are

advised that the film contains materials they might prefer

children under fifteen years not to see.

Category `12' Passed as suitable only for exhibition to persons of

twelve years and over. When a programme includes a

'12' film, no persons under twelve years can be

admitted.

Category '12a' Passed as suitable for children under the age of 12 if

accompanied by an adult.

Category `15' Passed as suitable only for exhibition to persons of

fifteen years and over. when a programme includes a

`15' film, no persons under fifteen years can be

admitted.

Category `18' Passed as suitable only for exhibition to adults. When

a programme includes an `18; film no persons under

the age of eighteen years can be admitted.

2.3 In addition to licensing premises for film exhibitions, the Licensing Authority has a duty under Section 20 of the Licensing Act 2003 to categorise a film which is absent of a Certificate from a film classification body such as the BBFC. The Licensing Authority may also reject or modify a film which has received a Certificate from the BBFC.

3.0 Main Issues

- 3.1 Application has been received to have a film certified by the Licensing Sub Committee.
- 3.2 Details of the film which requires certification including a brief synopsis and a recommended category in line with the BBFC classifications is attached at **Appendix A** for Members information.
- 3.3 The promoter of the film will not attend the hearing.
- 3.4 The film is to be shown at the Vue Cinema, 22 The Light, The Headrow, Leeds LS1 8TL which has the benefit of a Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003 with the provision of films.

4.0 History

- 4.1 This is the first time this film has been screened in the Leeds City Council area.
