1.3	There have been 12 calls for ASB in last 6 weeks most off which related to off road motorcycles. When caught the bikes can be confiscated.	
1.4	<ul> <li>CCTV cameras at Stanks Parade shops The shops have been visited by WYP but none of the shopkeepers seem prepared to take on the maintenance responsibility. </li> <li>Outer East Area Committee paid for the installation several years ago on the basis that the shopkeeper took on the responsibility for maintenance after the first year. They did agree to this but it appears that over the course of time this has changed. Action: It was agreed that this could not be further pursued without the co- operation of the shopkeepers. Southwood Road tenant issue Neighbour issue now resolved to satisfaction of both parties.</li></ul>

4.3	<ul> <li>KH reported on:</li> <li>The knit and natter group (to start in September)</li> <li>Various trips and outings provided</li> <li>The gardening scheme funded by Area Committee (to date 132 cuts and 72 follow ups)</li> </ul>	
5.0	Activities for young people – Coullin Meikle (Youth Work Manager)	
5.1	Virgil reported the following:	
	<ul> <li>32 universal sessions delivered in recent period</li> <li>Several residentials planned soon</li> <li>Work started with Youth Offending Service</li> <li>Discussed project called Voice, Influence and Change – this is where young people can influence decision making process for what provision there is in the area.</li> </ul>	
5.2	Local Councillors were thanked for MICE money for football kits and funding for the school holiday programme.	
5.3	MH reported that Area Committees now has a delegated budget for young people. The intention is to establish a Young Persons sub group chaired by the Area Committee Lead Member for Children, Cllr Coupar. This body will work with service providers and young people to determine how this budget is used. The sub group will make recommendations to Area Committee to fund project work from this source.	
5.4	Virgil confirmed that discussions are on-going to fill the gap on provision for children aged 6 to 12 years.	СМ

6.1	<ul> <li>Rent arrears and welfare reform issues remain priority work for staff and have taken up considerable staff time. The following information was also provided:</li> <li>9 Voids</li> <li>200 bids per property in Swarcliffe</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>9 community walkabouts in June</li> <li>Working with community payback to do new environmental projects</li> </ul>	
6.2	<b>Question</b> – Why not concentrate on already existing environmental schemes that are no longer maintained rather than creating new ones? <b>Agreed</b> – JL and Nathan Vaughn to investigate all environmental schemes and determine which one's aren't being maintained. They will then look at a programme for community payback	JL/NV
6.3	Cllr Grahame informed the meeting that Parks & Countryside now maintained plants around Welcome Stones. She agreed to contact Kris Nenadic to see if Sherburn Court can be included in their maintenance programme.	Cllr G

	<ul> <li>Role for AVH in monitoring new tenancies</li> <li>Tenure does not matter – action is taken regardless of tenure</li> <li>There will no longer be choice based lettings once ALMO's back with LCC in August</li> <li>Every tenancy will be visited at least once per year. To date 222 visits done.</li> </ul>
