Appendix 3 – Overview of services in the Housing Related Support Programme

371 units of accommodation and support are available for homeless families and singles provided by seven different organisations. These are St Georges Crypt, Leeds Housing Concern, St Anne's Community Services, Leeds Federated Housing Association, Riverside ECHG, Connect Housing Association and Leeds Action to Create Homes (LATCH).

266 units of floating support provided across four services for homeless families or single people requiring support to resettle into a property or sustain a tenancy. Services are provided by Great Places, Sanctuary Supported Living, Riverside ECHG and Connect Housing Association.

200 units of support are provided by Foundation to support people in temporary accommodation.

The Street Outreach service is provided by CRI to support rough sleepers to move off the streets into suitable accommodation.

Young Peoples Services

150 units of accommodation and support for young people and 255 units of floating support for young people provided by the Flagship service. Consortia members are GIPSIL, LHC and Foundation.

9 units of emergency access accommodation at the Seacole service provided by Leeds Housing Concern.

200 units of floating support for young people are provided by Re'new and 60 units of floating support are provided by GIPSIL specifically for Care Leavers.

Mental Health Services

69 units of accommodation and support are provided across four services. These are Rosevilla and the Maltings provided by Community Links, the Dispersed Accommodation Service provided by Touchstone and Foundry Mill provided by Catholic Care.

500 units of floating support for people living in their own homes provided by the Positive Pathways consortia service. This included Community Links, Leeds Mind, St Anne's Community Services, Touchstone and Leeds Irish Health and Homes.

Domestic Violence

26 units of accommodation are provided by Stonham Home Group via the Leeds Women's Refuge Service.

300 units of floating support are provided via the Integrated Outreach and Resettlement Service provided by a consortia consisting of Leeds Women's Aid, Behind Closed Doors and HALT.

Substance Misuse

There are a total of 66 units of accommodation and support for people with people with drug and alcohol issues including the Sinclair Project and Carr Beck and Carr Beck Group Homes both run by Leeds Housing Concern and Regents Terrace and Faith Lodge both run by St Georges Crypt.

A total of 72 units of floating support for people with drug and alcohol issues across 3 services are provided by St Georges Crypt, Leeds Housing Concern and St Anne's Community Services.

Offender Services

There are 73 units of accommodation provided across three services. These are the Kirkstall Lodge and South Leeds Tenancy Sustainment Services provided by Stonham Home Group and the Adult Offender Accommodation Based Service provided by Foundation.

159 units of floating support for offenders are provided by Foundation and Leeds Housing Concern and a further 200 units of support are provided by the Drug Intervention Programme (DIP) and Integrated Offender Management (IOM) services provided by CRI and DISC.

Exiting Prostitution

12 units of floating support are provided by Genesis.

Disability

74 units of floating support are provided for people with disabilities via three services provided by KeyRing Living Support Networks, Leeds Federated Housing Association and Connect Housing Association.

Older People

34 units of accommodation based support for Older People across two services provided by Housing 21 and Making Space.

212 units of floating support across four services provided by Creative Support, Age UK, Leeds Federated Housing Association and Connect Housing Association.

Handypersons services are provided by Care and Repair and 2606 units of Alarm Call support provided by 16 different organisations.
