SUBJECT: Land adjoining former site of WMC – 101 Lincoln Green Road. Proposed supermarket development

## **DETAILS:**

LEDA has recently considered a proposal from the Council's tenant ( Heron Foods ) to develop a supermarket on the site of the former working men's club. Identified as A on the plan.

Heron Foods have subsequently had pre-application discussions with planning services (Andrew Crates) and highways officers. Highways officers are understood to have advised that the level of car parking and delivery provision is considered to be unsatisfactory based on use of the existing lease area only. There also concerns with the junction. It is understood that planning officers are in principal supportive of retail development on this site.

Heron Foods have enquired as to whether the area of Council owned land identified cross-hatched could be made available in order to improve parking / delivery provision within the existing leased area. The current proposal is for the new building to be positioned in the north-east corner of the enlarged site. Please see attached the latest layout plan received from Heron's agent.

The additional area is not part of the adopted highway and is a grassed area with a small area of hard-standing on the northern boundary. Heron Foods have been intending to demolish the existing building at the earliest opportunity and have the received necessary permission from Building Control.

LEDA (Nathan Huntley) has previously advised that the cross-hatched area would not be required for any future NGT link but that the triangular area between the Beckett Street / Lincoln Green Road junction radii and footway should be reserved for future capacity improvements at the junctions. The triangular area is not being sought.

Members comments are requested in respect of inclusion of the cross-hatched area.


