Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence
 - a. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

Embedded Restrictions

4. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during the hours stated on this licence and:
 - a. On Christmas Day, 12 noon to 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 10.30 p.m.
 - b. On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).

The prevention of crime and disorder

5. Adopt the Check 21 proof of age scheme in accordance with guidance issued by West Yorkshire Police.
6. Operate an effective CCTV system to be maintained in accordance with guidelines issued by West Yorkshire Police.

It is the policy of the police in Leeds that where an applicant request to extend their operating hours a CCTV condition should apply where:-

- a. There are problems associated with crime and disorder;
- b. Operating hours are requested beyond 12 midnight, the venue is located outside a town centre or main village street and is in close proximity to a residential area;
- c. Where the venue is situated in a town, city centre or main village street and the police have reasonably held concerns regarding crime and disorder; and
- d. Where a CCTV system is already operating.
