Project Summary
<p>The Ley Lane area of Armley has been identified as a hotspot for crime and anti-social behaviour. During the summer, a multi-agency partnership supported four weekly sports and fun sessions on the nearby recreation ground to engage young people. The sessions were funded with a £1,960 grant from the Community Committee and proved very popular, culminating in an afternoon of family fun on Friday 22nd August.</p> <p>A working group has been set up involving a number of local residents to look at other opportunities to improve the local area and continue providing out of school activities for young people. The group will meet early in October, and the Community Committee is asked to consider providing a budget of £3,000 from the Wellbeing fund for the group to allocate to youth activities or equipment for the recreation ground. Interest has been expressed in providing rugby posts and sports coaching sessions.</p>

Targets for the project and how success will be measured
<p>The project will provide a group of local residents with a budget to commission activities for young people or purchase equipment for the Ley Lane.</p>

How the project will be promoted and/or participation encouraged
<p>The money will be spent in consultation with local parents and young people. Participation in the summer activities were very popular this is expected to continue.</p>

Exit strategy/How the project will continue after the funding
<p>The Area Support Team is working with the group of residents to access other funding pots to improve the recreation ground. It is hoped that the Youth Service will continue to deliver activities in this area.</p>
