SCHEDULE

THE PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

- 1. No single cans of beer, lager or cider will be sold.
- 2. In order to promote the prevention of crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance, the premises licence holder shall not sell super strength beer, lager or cider with an alcohol content of 6.5% ABV (alcohol by volume) or greater. This restriction shall not apply in respect of the specialist branded, premium priced, products for example craft ales, local or micro brewery specialist products, boxed gifts or national celebratory/commemorative beer, lager or cider with an alcohol content of 6.5% ABV or greater.
- 3. CCTV security footage will be made secure and retained for a minimum period of 31 days time to the satisfaction of West Yorkshire Police
- 4. All staff will receive suitable training (including refresher training) in relation to the proof of age "challenge 25" scheme to be applied on the premises. The following forms of identification are acceptable; photo driving licence, passport, proof of age standards scheme (pass) card and any other locally or nationally approved form of identification.
- 5. All checkout operators will operate a refusal log.
