Summary of main issues

Provision of Late Night Refreshment

Thursday to Saturday 23:00 to 01:00

Sunday to Wednesday 23:00 to 00:00

3.0 The Application

- 3.1 The applicant is J D Wetherspoon,
- 3.2 The application form may be found at **Appendix B** to this report.
- 3.3 In summary the application is to:-
 - First floor external customer area created.
 - Customer staircase added.
 - Disabled platform lift moved to customer staircase
 - Office relocated to ground floor.
 - Male and Female customer toilets reconfigured and first floor corridor added and general layout rearranged

No changes to licensable activities or hours are sought with this application.
