






Former Micklefield House & Micklefield Lodge, New Road Side, Rawdon

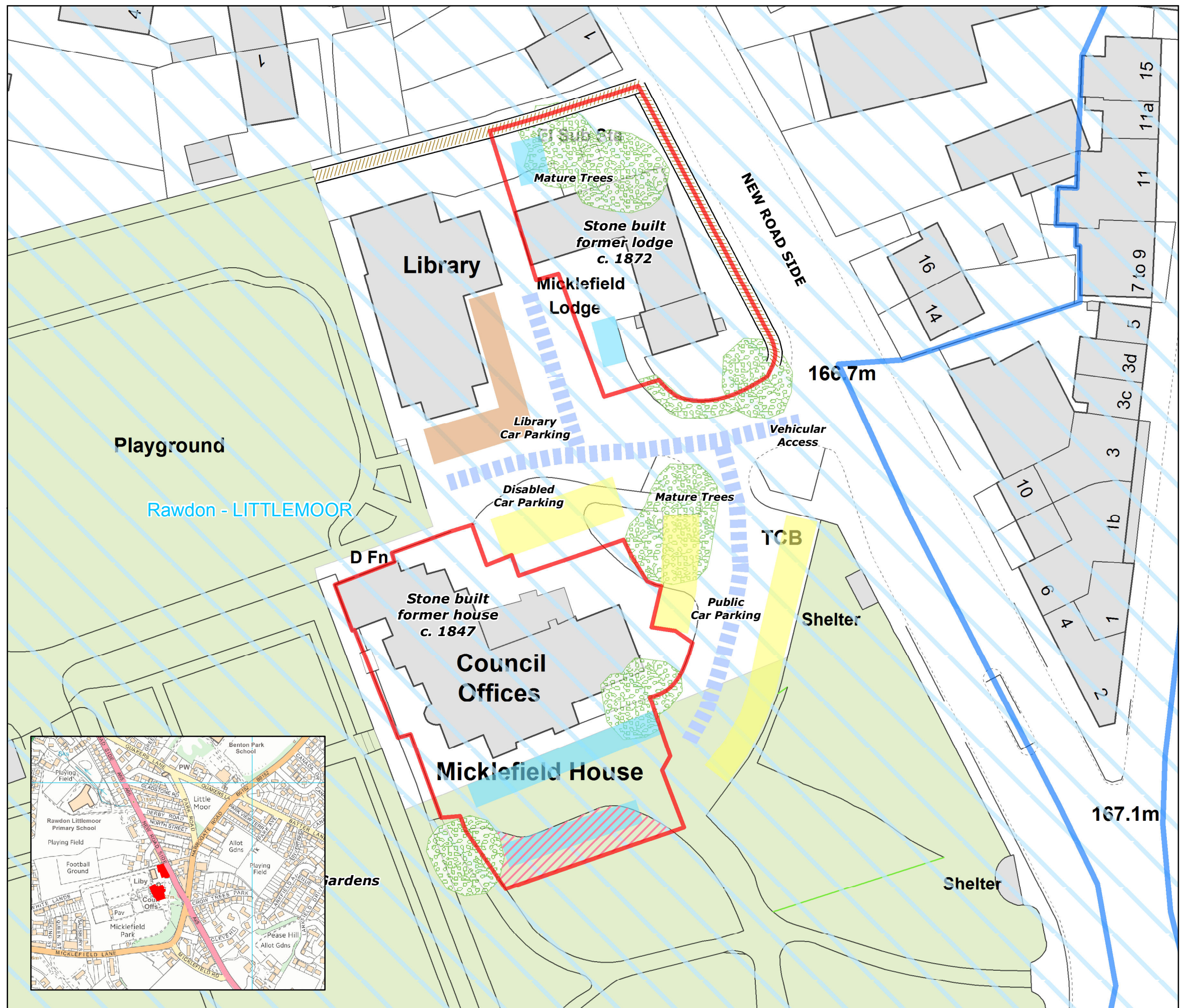
KEY ISSUES
