## • How have you considered equality, diversity, cohesion and integration?

The proposed diversions will affect people who use the public right of way network in this area. It will include recreational users as well as commuters and utility users. The diversion may affect lower income groups who are more likely to use the public rights of way network on foot or by bicycle because they do not have access to a car. Both Leeds City Council and the developers have consulted with relevant user groups including walkers, horse riders and cyclists.

# • Key findings

The proposed new routes will provide recreational routes for horse riders, cyclists and walkers. There will also be additional walking and cycling routes for utility trips and commuting on the routes included in the Order and on other routes to be provided by the developer. Some of these will provide shorter and more direct routes than those that currently exist as well as some new links that currently do not exist. The proposal has taken into account the needs of walkers, horse riders and cyclists in terms of the surfaces that they require for use.

## Actions

After receiving comments from cyclists an existing public footpath is to be upgraded to bridleway status to provide a more direct link for cyclists to use between the eastern and western ends of Barrowby Lane.
