## Scrutiny Board (Strategy and Resources and Council Services)

The Scrutiny Board (Strategy and Resources and Council Services) is authorised to discharge the following overview and scrutiny functions<sup>1</sup>:

- 1. to review or scrutinise decisions made or other action taken in connection with any council or executive function or any matter which affects the authority's area or the inhabitants of that area;2
- 2. to receive and consider requests for Scrutiny from any source;
- 3. to review or scrutinise the performance of such Trust / Partnership Boards as fall within its remit
- 2. to carry out such other reviews or policy development tasks as it may be requested to do by either the Executive Board or the Council;
- to act as the appropriate Scrutiny Board<sup>3</sup> in relation to the Executive's initial proposals for a plan or strategy<sup>4</sup> within the Budget and Policy Framework which falls within its remit;5
- to review or scrutinise executive decisions<sup>6</sup> that have been Called In; <del>4.</del>5. <u>and</u>
- 5. to review outcomes, targets and priorities within the Council Business Plan;
- 6. to receive requests for scrutiny and councillor calls for action and undertake any subsequent work; and
- to make such reports and recommendations as it considers appropriate and to receive and monitor formal responses to any reports or recommendations made.
