The proposed variation is to remove the following conditions from the Premises Licence which read as follows:-

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The prevention of crime and disorder

- 11. The Daily Record Register will contain consecutively numbered pages, the full name and registration number of each person on duty, the employer of that person and the date and time he/she commenced duty and finished duty. (Verified by the individual's signature).
- 16. A Supervisor's Register will be maintained at the licensed premises showing the names, addresses and up to date contacts details for the DPS and all personal licence holders.
- 17. The Supervisor's Register will state the names of the person who is in overall charge of the premises at each time that licensed activities are carried out, and this information will be retained for a period of twelve months and produced for inspection on request to any authorised officer.
- 20. A policy for searching patrons at the entrance to premises will be adopted and prominently displayed on the premises.
- 25. Plastic or toughened polycarbonate (or similar) glasses/bottles will be used in all outdoor areas.
- 26. Notices will be prominently displayed at the entrances of the premises which state: A search will be conducted as a condition of entry to the premises;

Incidents of crime and disorder will be reported to the plicy and a full recorded entry will be made in the Incident Report Register;

Entry to the premises will be refused to any person who appears to be drunk, acting in a threatening manner or is violent; or who appears to be under the influence of drugs;

Entry will be refused to any person who has been convicted of an offence of drunkenness, violence or threatening behaviour or the use or distribution of illegal substances.

29. The Daily Record Register will be retained on the premises for a period of twelve months from the date of the last entry.

34. The Premises Licence Holder/Designated Premises Supervisor will give 14 days' notice to the police and the licensing authority of all events to be held in Function Rooms 1 and 2.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

63. Noise from a licensable activity at the premises shall be inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive premises after 23:00 hours and at all times if entertainment takes place on more than 30 occasions per year.

To amend condition 14 of Annex 2 which currently reads:- "No licensable activities of any description including no Mobile bars or any other type of alcohol dispense point shall be used at any time in the external area (as identified on Plan 20113/328 refer produced by Phoenix Architecture and Interiors Limited)" to the proposed wording of "No licensable activities of any description, including no Mobile bars or any other type of alcohol dispense point shall be used at any time in the external area (as identified on Plan 20113/328 refer produced by Phoenix Architecture and Interiors Limited), except the sale of alcohol by way of waiter/waitress service".

To remove the following wording from condition 66 of Annex 2 "Noise from plant or machinery shall be inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive premises during the operation of the plant or machinery". The condition will then read "Plant and machinery shall be regularly serviced and maintained to meet this level".

To amend condition 67 of Annex 2 which currently reads:- "The PLH/DPS will ensure patrons use beer gardens, external areas and play areas in a manner which does not cause disturbance to nearby residents and business in the vicinity. Patrons will not use such areas after 23:00 hours" to the proposed wording of "The PLH/DPS will ensure patrons use beer gardens, external areas and play areas in a manner which does not cause disturbance to nearby residents and business in the vicinity. Patrons will not use such areas after **Midnight**".
