Summary of Project:

The Girl Guides are the leading charity for girls and young women in the UK and the Calverley Village Guide Association runs five groups. Attendance at the group builds confidence, raises aspirations and allows girls to discover and fulfil their potential, while encouraging them to be a powerful force for good.

The dry stone wall needs to be rebuilt around the grounds as it is essential that the premises are kept safe and the group is responsible for maintaining and making safe this boundary wall in order to avoid injury to the public. This has been inspected by dry stone walling experts and the group has been advised that this needs to be done before winter 2015/16.

The benefit to the community will be that the wall will no longer be a potential hazard to the public. An additional benefit to the community will be that the rebuilding will match visually similar walling projects, undertaken by Otley Drystone Wallers (who the group intends to use) using old stone, which have previously taken place in the ward area.

In addition to the general public, 100 adults and girls (5 years to adult) will benefit from this rebuild.
