# Summary of main issues

- The City Solicitor attended the Scrutiny Board's meeting in June to discuss the Board's terms of reference in accordance with the Officer Delegation Scheme (Executive functions). Whilst acknowledging that this Scrutiny Board is aligned to the Executive functions of the Director of Environment and Housing, Members agreed that the delegation scheme, as written in the Constitution, was insufficiently clear.
- 2. The City Solicitor advised that a review of the wording of the existing delegation scheme would be undertaken by the Head of Governance Services. Pending this review, the Board requested that a 'plain English' list of the Director of Environment and Housing areas of responsibility be brought back to the Board's July meeting in order for members of this Board to be clear as to its remit. A list of the areas of responsibility, including relevant senior officer contact details, is attached as Appendix 1. A separate list of relevant housing related functions is also attached as Appendix 2.
