Application is made to approve an extension to the premises as indicated on plan 9890-07 deposited with the licensing authority.

The premises are to benefit from an extension which will increase the licensed area of the ground floor and also seeks to incorporate the first floor of the premises within the licensed area. The extension is to be located at the rear of the premises which is currently a patio area.

The ground floor is to be enhanced and extended through the relocation of the female toilets. This relocation will extend the restaurant facility on offer and the female toilets will be located in the extended area at the rear of the premises. The extension will also provide to improved access for customers as the staircase will be enhanced and an additional access point will be installed at the rear in the extended area.

Refurbishment will be undertaken to the first floor to bring this into the licensed area and increase the amenities on offer by the premises. This will also include the installation of a bar servery which will provide additional supervision to the upstairs area.

It is the intention of the applicant to extend all licensable activities to the areas outlined in red on the deposited plans.

The relevant plan to be attached to the licence, if this application is successful is to be drawing number 9890-07; however to assist with this application, please see attached plan 9890-02B proposed ground floor and plan 9890-03B proposed first floor plan. These plans provide more detail as to the fire safety precautions in place at the premises.

Please note that this application is not intended to alter the external licensed area which will remain licensed as per drawing no. E0415/91641/0.1.

The nature of the operation is to remain unchanged and the extension is to improve facilities offered by the premises.

In that no hours or activities are being altered by this application, boxes A – K have not been completed and all activities authorised by the premises licence are to continue within the extended areas.

It is not anticipated that the intended changes will adversely affect the four licensing objectives and the application has been prepared on this basis.
