## 1 Purpose of this report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide supplementary information to the Scrutiny Board (City Development) which was not available at the time of agenda publication.

## 2 Main Issues

- 2.1 The scope of the inquiry agreed by the Scrutiny Board in September 2015 makes direct reference to the connectivity and infrastructure across Leeds currently and future plan in order to identify how areas could be excluded or disadvantaged.
- 2.2 On the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2015 The Department of Culture Media and Sport select committee announced their intention to undertake and inquiry into 'Establishing world-class connectivity throughout the UK' and invited written submissions. The terms of reference are attached as appendix A. The West Yorkshire Combined Authority provided a written response on the 30<sup>th</sup> of September which the authority has kindly agreed to share with the Scrutiny Board.
