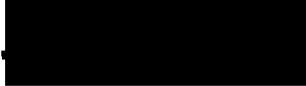

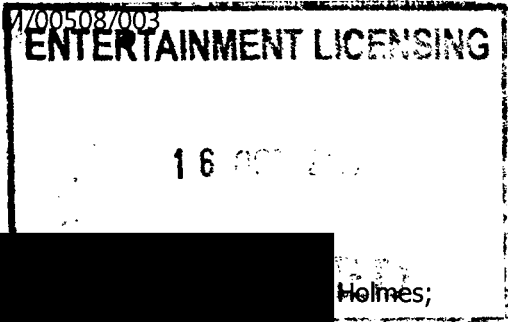

Following last night's Planning & Licensing Committee consideration concerning Maverick's, we would like to add:

"Horsforth Town Council does not feel that the proposals agreed with environmental health and the conditions offered by the applicant alleviate any of our concerns. The Council still objects to the proposed licensing variation at Maverick's, due to the extended opening hours and the issues raised in our initial comments, and still wishes to proceed with our representation.

In addition, we wish to draw attention to Leeds City Council's Draft Statement of Licensing Policy 2014 - 2018, which states:

"It is the council's policy, on receipt of relevant representations, to refuse new and variation applications in Area 4 (i.e. Horsforth) for the following premises:

- Alcohol led premises such as bars, pubs and clubs.
- Café bars and restaurants.
- Premises seeking late night refreshment such as takeaways and late opening restaurants."

Thank you for allowing Horsforth Town Council the time to discuss the proposal and provide this additional information.
