To clarify for those reviewing this application, the purpose of this application is to replace the existing licence to provide for

extended hours for licensable activities and opening. The licence is currently subject to various outdated and redundant conditions, and as such an entirely new operating schedule is proposed, which incorporates any relevant conditions from the current licence and makes significant additions. Specific differences between the current licence, and the licence applied for in the course of this application can be detailed as follows:

1. The hours for sale of alcohol and provision of regulated entertainment are to be increased to 10:00 - 03:00 Sunday to Thursday and to 10:00 - 04:00 Friday and Saturday (plus 30 minutes dispersal).
2. The hours for late night refreshment are to be increased to 23:00 - 03:30 Sunday to Thursday and to 23:00 - 04:30 Friday and Saturday.
3. The maximum occupancy for the premises is reduced from a total of 450 persons to 375 persons (excluding staff).
4. The following conditions are additional to those attached to the current premises licence:
 - 'A minimum of 1 member of SIA registered door staff shall be employed at the premises from 21:00 until close Sunday to Thursday, and a minimum of 2 members of SIA registered door staff shall be employed at the premises from 21:00 until close Friday to Saturday.'
 - 'From 18:00 daily, the first floor of the premises will be accessible only to customers who are dining, and the sale of alcohol shall be ancillary to food (with the exception of private hire events).'
 - 'The first floor of the premises will be closed to customers at 02:00 daily to encourage gradual dispersal'
 - 'No entry shall be permitted to the premises after 02:00 Sunday to Thursday and 03:00 Friday to Saturday, (with the exception of returning smokers)'
 - 'The management will come to an arrangement with a private hire taxi company who will offer a ring back service. Customers will be encouraged to wait inside for their taxis'
 - 'Hot food will be available at the premises until 03:30 on Fridays and Saturdays'
5. An updated dispersal policy is to be added.

Please see attached the proposed operating schedule and dispersal policy, as well as a risk assessment document which details how the hours will be managed to ensure that the grant of this licence will not add to the cumulative impact in the area.
