Licensing Act 2003 - Application for the grant of a premises licence for:
Premises: Premier Inn, Arndale House, Otley Road (at Its Junction With Alma Road),

I wish to object to the above application for a premises licence.

Headingley is a vibrant community which has for many years struggled with an over-abundance of licensed premises with well documented problems of associated CRIME AND DISORDER as confirmed by West Yorkshire Police.

This application goes against the Cumulative Impact Policy set up in the area to address such issues. As a local resident living [REDACTED] the Arndale Centre I have had to sluice vomit from in front of my gate, report drunken brawls and other examples of PUBLIC DISORDER to the police on more than one occasion and have repeatedly been woken by night time noise.

The proposed venue is sited within the vicinity of a local Primary School and the licensing hours for the general public are from 10am to 0.30 am every day, covering the majority of a school day and thereby failing to PROTECT CHILDREN FROM HARM. The 24 hour license for Hotel residents exposes the whole of the Headingley residential and commercial community and visitors to the shopping centre in which the premises is located to all of the above problems.
