The Council's Environmental Health hereby give you Notice that we are objecting to this Temporary Event Notice as we are satisfied that by allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine a licensing objective of prevention of public nuisance for the following reasons:

The premises are surrounded by residential properties and over the years an Environmental Health have received noise nuisance complaints from the residents by way of amplified music escaping from the premises and noise disturbance caused by coming and goings of patrons.

It is, therefore advised that in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 the Council's Licensing Section serve counter notice in relation to this application.
