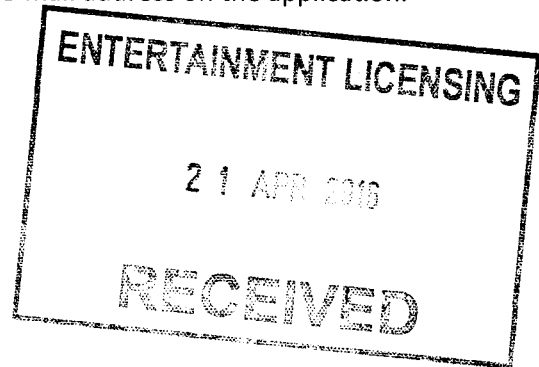

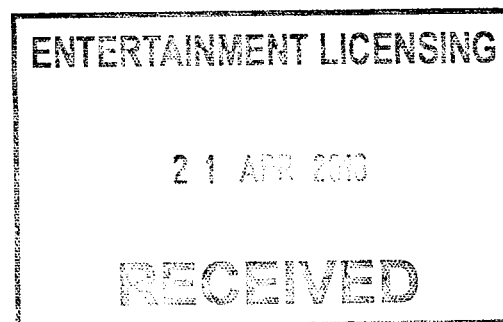

West Yorkshire Police object outright to your application for the following reasons:

You are shown on police systems as connected to the previous applicant for a premises licence at this address, Hassan Hashemi, and it is therefore strongly suspected that you are a front for Mr.Hashemi, and that this application is a deliberate attempt to mislead West Yorkshire Police and the Licensing Authority.

The reasons for our objections to Mr.Hashemi, outlined in a letter of objection dated 21st May 2015, remain the same, and I will include that previous letter as additional evidence to support this objection at any future hearing, and evidence his connections with a male called Halil Yildizhan.

Mr.Hassan Hashemi remains of interest to West Yorkshire Police as part of an ongoing criminal investigation.
