#### Structural changes and the removal of embedded restrictions and conditions are also proposed.

It is the opinion of West Yorkshire Police, that your application contains insufficient information on how you will achieve the licensing objectives. In particular, we cannot be satisfied at this stage that, if granted the premises would not adversely affect crime and disorder and/or public nuisance in the locality.

I have spoken to the Neighbourhood Policing Team (NPT), for the Morley area, who have concerns in relation to this establishment. The calls for service to the venue are significant. West Yorkshire Police have received multiple calls for police assistance where customers are reported to be fighting. Reports have been received that people have been punched, bitten and glassed. Large scale disorder is also reported as being linked to the premises.

# FOR THE REASONS SET OUT ABOVE WEST YORKSHIRE POLICE ARE OF THE OPINION THAT THIS APPLICATION SHOULD BE REFUSED IN FULL.
