I would like to object to the proposed licence application for the following reasons:

- * The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
 - Alcohol increases crime and disorder. Driving to buy Alcohol whilst under the influence is a criminal offence and a danger to the public
- * The Prevention of Public Nuisance.
 - The increases risk of anti social behaviour from selling alcohol from 0600-2300
 - Drinking outside in public areas
- * Public Safety
 - Increased traffic, speeding, drink driving
 - Risk of increase of litter , especial bottles and broken glass risking public safety
- * The Protection of Children from Harm.
 - There is a great risk to children as there are schools very close, either side of the post office in walking distance.

The sale of alcohol should be restricted and the right to sell not given out freely to profit.
I note that the post office is already having new shelves fitted which leads me to believe like other planning application on this street, it will go ahead without a care of public opinion
