Overview and Scrutiny Board - Cancer Services

Desired Outcome: Greater collaboration across Leeds' health and social care economy in order to provide improved levels of patient experience data, specifically in relation to cancer services.

Recommendation 5: That by September 2016, Healthwatch Leeds, in consultation with the Director of Public Health, assesses the current level of patient experience data it holds specifically in relation to the prevention, early diagnosis and treatment of cancer, and considers its potential future role in collating such data on behalf of partners across the Leeds' health and social care economy landscape.

Healthwatch Leeds (HWL) will undertake to review any cancer related feedback that it holds by 30 September 2016 and to share the summary with the Director of Public Health. Our current recording system does not categorise the subsections of prevention, early diagnoses and treatment but we will review the categories to establish if such differentiation is possible.

HWL will invite their stakeholders and partners to share appropriate summary data on the cancer experiences and where provided, will include that information in the report.

The summary report will be made available to all respondents and the Scrutiny by 31 October 2016
