PLANNING APPLICATION OBJECTION
THE MEWS, WETHERBY - REF PREM/00217/005

I wish to place my objection to certain items in the above planning application.

- **Extended opening hours from 11:30am to the earlier time of 09:00am**
 - To open at 09:00am would add to the already busy traffic in Bank Street and Church Street. It is at around this time that parents leave the area in their cars having dropped infants off at the Nursery School.
 - Bank Street is a very busy street at this time also, not only with cars, but also pedestrians.
 - It is worth noting the Church Street is a private road, and not to be used by Muse customers.

- **Closure extended to midnight from 23:00, with no restrictions to the use of the beer garden.**
 - If the extended hour is to be granted, then it would be respectful to the local residents for patrons to go inside. There are a number of flats in Bank Street and Church Street that are not outwardly visible.
 - There is already a great deal of excessive and unnecessary noise from staff clearing and stacking chairs, removing umbrellas, plus one female (presumably a waitress) who frequently screams 'important' news across the courtyard.

I for one, certainly do not welcome these proposed changes, and for the genuine reasons outlined above, strongly object to the extended opening hours.

If you are familiar with the site you will know that these cottages are less than 20 feet from the "the beer garden" which has an open aspect.

Sadly the Muse is not complying with it's current Mandatory conditions. All notices requesting consideration for the residents of Church Street and vacating the beer garden by 1100HRS. were removed some months ago during a refurbishment. Furthermore on warm evenings the beer garden is sometimes not vacated until well after 11.00 pm followed by jolly staff tidying up
