1 Purpose of this report

To seek approval to appoint Members to two Outside Bodies in Accordance with the Appointments to Outside Bodies Procedure Rules.

2 Background information

2.1 In accordance with the Appointments to Outside Bodies Procedure Rules (4.6) the City Solicitor will have delegated authority to make an appointment where a group whip is seeking to alter an appointment allocated to their Group by Member Management Committee. The City Solicitor has sub delegated such authority to The Head of Governance and Scrutiny Support.
