M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

- 1. The Chief Constable of the West Yorkshire Police, any Police Officer, the Chief Fire Office, any authorised officer in uniform of the West Yorkshire Fire Authority, any authorised Environmental Health Officer and their equipment and any other person authorised by the Licensing Authority shall have free access to all parts of the licensed premises at all reasonable times for the purpose of supervising the observance and enforcement of these conditions.
- 2. The premises will operate in conjunction with the standard conditions attached to the SEV licence.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1. The licensee, or some other responsible person not less than eighteen years of age and nominated in writing for the purpose, shall be in charge of, and remain upon the licensed premises whenever they are used for licensed purposes. They shall not be engaged in any duties which prevent them from exercising general supervision and control.
- 2. The person in charge of the premises shall be conversant with all of the premises licence conditions and standard conditions attached to the SEV Licence.
- 3. No open containers of alcohol sold for consumption off the premises to be taken from the premises.
- 4. The PLH/DPS participate in a local Pubwatch scheme or licensing association, (where one exits) that is recognised by West Yorkshire Police.
- 5. A Supervisor's Register will be maintained at the licensed premises, showing the names, addresses and up-to-date contact details for the DPS and all personal licence holders.
- 6. The Supervisor's Register will state the name of the person who is in overall charge of the premises at each time that licensed activities are carried out, and this information will be retained for a period of twelve months and produced for inspection on request to an authorised officer.
- 7. The Premises Licence Holder (PLH)/Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) will ensure that a 'Daily Record Register' is maintained on the premises by the door staff.
- 8. The Daily Record Register will contain consecutively numbered pages, the full name and registration number of each person on duty, the employer of that person and the date and time he/she commenced duty and finished duty (verified by the individual's signature).
- 9. The Daily Record Register will be retained on the premises for a period of twelve months from the date of the last entry.
- 10. There will be a communication link via radio to other venues in the city centre. This will be the system recognised by the current Business Crime Reduction Partnership for the city, Leeds City Council and West Yorkshire Police.
- 11. Such communication link will be kept in working order at all times when licensable activities are taking place.
- 12. The communication link will be available to the Designated Premises Supervisor or other nominated supervisor and be monitored by that person at all times that licensed activities are being carried out.
- 13. A suitable purpose made receptacle for the safe retention of illegal substances will be provided and arrangements made for the sale disposal of its contents as agreed with West Yorkshire Police or British Transport Police.
- 14. Price lists will be clearly displayed at each table and at each entrance to the premises.
- 15. Entertainers will only be present in the licensed area in a state of nudity when they are performing on stage or providing a private dance.
- 16. All areas used for private dances must be visible to supervision and must not have closing doors or curtains that prevent performances from being observed.
- 17. All areas used for private dances must be directly supervised by either a SIA registered door supervisor, or a member of staff who has direct contact with SIA registered door supervisors working on the premises at all times the booths/areas are in use. Direct supervision does not include remote supervision by CCTV.

c) Public safety

- 1. Before opening to the public, checks will be undertaken to ensure all access to the premises are clear for emergency vehicles. Regular checks will be undertaken when the premises are open.
- 2. Written records of all accidents and safety incidents involving members of the public will be kept. These will be made available at the request of an authorised officer.
- 3. A suitably trained and competent person must ensure regular safety checks of the premises including decorative and functional fixtures, floor surfaces and equipment (including electrical appliances) to which the public may come in to contact are undertaken. Records of these safety checks must be kept and made available for inspection by an authorised officer.
- 4. Electrical installations will be inspected on a periodic basis (at least every 3 years or at a frequency specified in writing) by a suitably qualified and competent person. Inspection records/certificates will be kept and made available at the request of an authorised officer. If used, any temporary electrical wiring and distributions will also be inspected. Inspection records/certificates will be kept. These will be made available at the request of an authorised officer.

- 5. A written spillage policy will be kept to ensure spillages are dealt with in a timely and safe manner.
- 6. Adequate and appropriate First Aid equipment and materials will be available on the premises at all times.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- 1. Nothing shall be done, recited sung, exhibited, or performed which is likely to cause a breach of the peace.
- 2. The designated premises supervisor (and any door supervisors if they are on duty) will monitor the activity of persons leaving the premises and remind them of their public responsibilities where necessary.
- 3. A facility will be provided for customers to order hackney taxis/private hire vehicles. Telephone numbers for taxi firms/private hire companies will be displayed in a prominent position on the premises.
