#### Description of the Event

A Charity Boxing Night in aid of the childrens cancer charity Candlelighters.

The event will comprise of 5 boxing matches and in between the matches will feature a comedian, music, an MC/Compere along with a raffle and an auction of sporting memorabilia. Legendary boxing referee Micky Vann will be refeering all of the matches.

The event is a ticketed only event and have been priced at £10.

All 350 tickets have been sold. A large proportion of ticket holders are known to the DPS/Event holder. The majority of the individuals who have purchased tickets are aged over 35 years.

#### **Insurance & Medical Provision**

The event is fully insured and standard medical provisions will be in place.

### The Prevention of Crime & Disorder & Public Safety

We will employ 6 SIA registered door staff from the security firm Pro-tech with whom we have had no previous incidents with.

A meeting with Pro-tech management and Paul Owen as DPS will be arranged in advance of the event to confirm the procedure for crowd control and dispersal. This will then be briefed to the staff prior to the commencement of the event. The club will also be requesting experienced door supervisors, ideally one of which should be female.

No glassware will be allowed outside of the club and door supervisors will be positioned to prevent this.

No persons aged under 22 will be admitted to the event.

Any bags that are brought into the event will be searched by SIA registered door staff on admission to the premises.

Ticket holders upon entry will be given an orange coloured wrist band with "boxing" labelled on it.

The club will appoint a car park attendant to assist with managing the flow of people and cars within the car parking area.

The club has a fully operational and up to date 16 camera HD CCTV system.
