Please see the agreements reached with the applicant below. Subject to the agreed measures being incorporated in to the operating schedule of the new premises licence, and the agreed revised times for licensable activities and closing times being applied, I can confirm on behalf of West Yorkshire Police that the objection to the application is withdrawn.

Please note that the agreements on timings reached differ from those timings suggested by Environmental Protection in relation to sales of alcohol.

I have visited the premises and met the applicant and I am confident that the nature of the operation is indeed an online gaming café. My initial concerns around the extensive hours applied for have been addressed by the agreed reduction in hours. Safeguarding issues have been discussed and an offer made in relation to no under 18s on the premises after 22:00hrs. The applicant is aware of the issues with antisocial behaviour in the area and does not wish to attract anything further and has agreed to refuse entry to any individuals which West Yorkshire Police indicate should not be allowed entry.

We are therefore satisfied that the granting of a premises licence to the applicant will not undermine the licensing objectives.
