- 6 At all times when licensable activities are taking place, there shall be a member of staff on duty who is able to operate the CCTV system, including downloading of footage on request of a police or licensing enforcement officer
- 7 The premises licence holder will ensure that an incident reporting system is maintained on the premises to record incidents such as but not limited to, anti-social behaviour admissions refusals and ejections from the premises
- 8 The system will be capable of recording the date , time and location of any incident, details of the nature of the incident

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and the names, where known, of any persons involved

- 9 Records from the system shall be retained for a minimum period of 12 months and be capable of being produced on request of a police or licensing enforcement officer
- 10 A suitable purpose-made receptacle for the safe retention of illegal substances will be provided and arrangements made for the safe disposal of its contents as agreed with West Yorkshire Police

- 5 The premises licence holder will use all reasonable measures to ensure that drinks, open bottles and glasses will not be taken from the premises onto the public highway at any time. For the purpose of this condition, "premises" includes any outside area falling within the demise of the premises or any area authorised for use under a street cafe licence or similar issued by Leeds City Council. This condition will not preclude the sale for consumption of alcoholic drinks off the premises where such drinks are sold in sealed containers.
