I wish to lodge the strongest possible objection to the above application for an alcohol licence

I have lived at this address for almost 34 years and am extremely well informed, from long personal experience, about the public nuisance problems of **noise** from alcohol-centered gatherings, the **disturbance** caused by people walking to and, particularly, from such gatherings, and the **inconvenience and danger** of streets clogged with cars parked by others attending them

The public nuisance effects of the arrival and departure of thousands of customers (3000 at weekends!) and hundreds of cars (500 at weekends!) anticipated by J D Wetherspoon's will be devastating for everyone living in the Buckinghams, Richmonds and Manors, and will also impinge negatively on residents on the other side of Headingley Lane (Oakfield, The Poplars, Orville Gardens, North Grange Road etc) The impact on Headingley Lane itself, already subject to very frequent traffic-flow problems, will be similarly negative

Granting an alcohol licence to J D Wetherspoon's for the proposed pub on Headingley Lane will condemn local residents to insufferable public nuisance and I profoundly hope that you will listen to my objections and those of my neighbours and refuse the licence application
