In December 2015 Executive Board approved the principal of a project to expand Park Spring Primary from 315-420 places with effect from September 2017, along with a funding envelope of £4.9m assigned to deliver the necessary construction works. 2. To manage traffic pressure and parking pressure on Wellstone Avenue, planning permission has been granted to build a new entrance and car park on Swinnow Lane. 3. To facilitate the construction of the car park a desire line needs to be re-routed. 4. The most cost effective method to re-route the desire line is to dedicate it from start to finish as a Public Right of Way. <p>Recommendations</p> <p>The Director of City Development is requested to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approve the request to dedicate the desire line as a Public Right of Way.
