# Comparison of BIS-SFA 16/17 Conditions of Funding (CoF) to Education-ESFA 17/18 CoF

# **Summary**

The Education and Skills Funding Agency 2017/18 Conditions of Funding (CoF) is significantly different from 2016/17, but does not have any conditions that prevent the Council accepting the ESFA funding contract for 2017/18.
