CGR2	Barwick in Elmet & Scholes Parish Council	Degroup current Barwick in Elmet & Scholes Parish Council to form a separate Barwick in Elmet Parish Council and a Scholes Parish Council	The response to the second consultation period clearly showed residents in both the Barwick Ward and Scholes Ward favoured the Parish Council remaining as it is. Of those who responded to the consultation, 206 were in favour of degrouping, and 1,131 were against degrouping
CGR4	Proposed Garforth Parish Council	Establish a Parish Council for Garforth for the area proposed by the Garforth Parish Project Board	<p>All parties agreed the proposed boundaries were not feasible. In addition most Members felt there was insufficient response from electors during the second consultation to justify the creation of a new parish council.</p> <p>All parties agreed the proposal should be rejected and that it was not appropriate to propose amended boundaries.</p>
