Homes Ltd) have paid the Local Authority Section 106 education contributions totalling £291,117.91 to be used "towards the provision of and/or improvement of educational facilities within the administrative area of the Council required as a consequence of the development".

Adel Primary School (PS) and Adel St John The Baptist C of E Primary School are the two nearest primary schools to the former DWP site, Otley Road development. Adel PS is 0.59 miles (straight line distance) and Adel St John's is 0.54 miles away.

On roll data from November 2023 shows there are currently 8 children attending Adel PS and 3 children attending Adel St John's who are living on the development. Due to the close proximity of both schools to the development, it has been decided to split the S106 education contributions equally between the two schools.

Both schools will continue to provide a long-term solution to meet the housing generated demand from this development. Therefore, it is appropriate for the S106 education contributions, paid by the developers of this site, to be directed towards meeting the capital cost of improvement works at both schools.

Adel PS has proposed a range of improvement works including refurbishment of the Early Years outdoor area, playground and computer suite (including purchasing new computers and iPads). There are also plans to enhance the school's nature conservation area to make it an accessible teaching space.

At January 2024's Good Learning Places Board, support was given to allocate £145,558.96 of Section 106 education contributions, paid to the Local Authority by Bellway Homes Ltd, against school improvement works at Adel Primary School.

Brief details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the decision maker at the time of making the decision

Adel Primary School is one of the closest primary schools to the former DWP site, Otley Road development and is popular with the families living there. There are no other suitable options available that would meet the conditions of the Section 106 agreement in question.

Allocating the S106 education funding to school improvement works at Adel Primary School will ensure places remain available to meet future demand from this development. Therefore, providing Adel Primary School with this funding is a good value for money option.
