(Set out all necessary decisions to be taken by the decision taker including decisions in relation to exempt information, exemption from call-in etc.)</p> <p>The Head of Learning Systems:</p> <p>a) Granted approval to allocate £145,558.96 of S106 education contributions paid by the housing developers of the former DWP site, Otley Road (Bellway Homes Ltd) towards the costs of school improvement works at Adel St John The Baptist C of E Primary School.</p> <p>b) Granted approval to inject into the capital programme and authority to spend of up to £145,558.96 of S106 education contributions (reference 13/04008) for school improvement works at Adel St John The Baptist C of E Primary School.</p> <p>c) Noted that at its January 2024 meeting, the Good Learning Places Board supported the use of the former DWP site, Otley Road (Bellway Homes Ltd) S106 education contributions towards the costs of school improvement works at Adel St John The Baptist C of E Primary School.</p>

	<p>A brief statement of the reasons for the decision (Include any significant financial, procurement, legal or equalities implications, having consulted with Finance, PACS, Legal, HR and Equality colleagues as appropriate)</p> <p>The housing developers of the former DWP site, Otley Road (Bellway Homes Ltd) have paid the Local Authority Section 106 education contributions totalling £291,117.91 to be used “towards the provision of and/or improvement of educational facilities within the administrative area of the Council required as a consequence of the development”.</p> <p>Adel St John The Baptist C of E Primary School and Adel Primary School (PS) are the two nearest primary schools to the former DWP site, Otley Road development. Adel St John’s is 0.54 miles (straight line distance) and Adel PS is 0.59 miles away.</p> <p>On roll data from November 2023 shows there are currently 3 children attending Adel St John’s and 8 children attending Adel PS who are living on the development. Due to the close proximity of both schools to the development, it has been decided to split the S106 education contributions equally between the two schools.</p> <p>Both schools will continue to provide a long-term solution to meet the housing generated demand from this development. Therefore, it is appropriate for the S106 education contributions, paid by the developers of this site, to be directed towards meeting the capital cost of improvement works at both schools.</p> <p>Adel St John’s has proposed a range of improvement works including the development of a Reception outdoor classroom, the installation of a MUGA (Multi Use Games Area) and an upgrade to the computer suite (including purchasing desktop PCs and computer chairs).</p> <p>At January 2024’s Good Learning Places Board, support was given to allocate £145,558.96 of Section 106 education contributions, paid to the Local Authority by Bellway Homes Ltd, against school improvement works at Adel St John The Baptist C of E Primary School.</p>
	<p>Brief details of any alternative options considered and rejected by the decision maker at the time of making the decision</p> <p>Adel St John’s is one of the closest primary schools to the former DWP site, Otley Road development and there are children attending the school from within the development. There are no other suitable options available that would meet the conditions of the Section 106 agreement in question.</p> <p>Allocating the S106 education funding to school improvement works at Adel St John’s will ensure places remain available to meet future demand from this development. Therefore, providing Adel St John’s with this funding is a good value for money option.</p>
