	The only feasible alternative option would have be not to proceed with the Grow: Project strand. However, following Executive Board approval, Grow: Project was announced as part of the Leeds Cultural Investment Programme which launched in October 2023 and opened for applications in November 2023. Not progressing with this funding proposal presented key risks to the Council and applicants to the programme. This would have denied the opportunity for individual artists and organisations to create work to share with audiences and participants across the city.
