## **Executive Summary**

Members have previously approved the introduction of English Comprehension testing prior to the grant of a Private Hire / Hackney Carriage driver licence and in other certain circumstances.

This report sets out the assessment statistics from December 2007.

#### 1.0 PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

1.1 To keep Members informed of the assessment results that Thomas Danby College undertake on behalf of the Council.

#### 2.0 BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2.1 The Licensing and Regulatory Panel previously approved the introduction of English Comprehension testing prior to the grant of a Hackney Carriage or Private Hire driver licence and in certain other cases.
- 2.2 Testing has been taking place in line with the Licensing and Regulatory Panels approval.

#### 3.0 MAIN ISSUES

- 3.1 There appears to consistent thread in terms of failure rates which justifies not only the introduction of the testing but also retention of the policy to continue with this requirement.
- 3.2 Members should be aware that on failure the applicant is offered training options which will assist them to improve their language skills and ultimately obtain a licence from this Council.
