SUBJECT: REVISED MEMBERSHIP OF THE ADMISSION FORUM IN THE NEW

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS CODE

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To inform the Admission Forum of the revised membership of the Leeds Admission Forum required by the School Admissions (Local Authority Reports and Admission Forums) (England) Regulations 2008 ("the Regulations") following consideration by the Leeds City Council Executive Board at it's meeting on I April 2009.

2. Background Information

- 2.1 The Education Act 2002 required each local authority to establish an Admissions Forum and the membership was agreed at an Executive Board meeting in January 2003. The Regulations and the new School Admissions Code have made significant alterations to the membership of the Admission Forum, and it was necessary to seek the approval of the Executive Board to establish the new revised membership.
- 2.2 The Admission Forum received a report upon the necessary changes to the Forum's membership at it's last meeting on 20 January 2009. The Forum made recommendations upon the membership which were conveyed to the Executive Board

3. KEY ISSUES

- The key role of the Admission Forum is in ensuring a fair admissions system that promotes social equity and it must act in accordance with the School Admissions Code issued by the DCSF.
- The membership of the Admission Forum required changes to comply with the Regulations and DCSF Guidance. The Forum must now contain no more than 20 members and taking into account the Regulations and Guidance the revised membership is as follows.
