

## **Resident feedback to Gating Order review consultation** **Wellingtons, Bramley**

### **In favour**

“We have seen almost zero crime / vandalism / ASB since the alleygating. All residents consider it a great success.”

“Less car vandalism and drunk people cutting through from the nearby pub.”

“Less non-residents walking up the street, so theft from the garden has reduced.”

“Very good idea.”

“No noisy kids hanging about in alleyway...Should have put them in 20 years ago!”
